



Overview

Each year at the Summit, the South County Economic Development Council (SCEDC) awards local community and business leaders in the South County and Baja regions for their personal and professional efforts to better the communities they live and work in that directly make an impact with economic development.

In order to be eligible for an award the nominee must live, do business in, or have an office in South San Diego County. **All nomination forms must be submitted to SCEDC by August 31, 2010 to be considered and will be kept confidential.** Winner information will be released during Summit activities.

Criteria

There are four award categories to choose from. The criterion for each award is listed below. Please select one category for submission.

Bi-National Endeavor Award – Sponsored by Parsons Brinckerhoff

The Bi-National Endeavor Award is presented to a leader (business or citizen) who has committed extended efforts to continue fostering relationships and promote economic growth on both sides of the border.



Regional Leadership Award – Sponsored by Union Bank

The Regional Leadership Award honors a South County entity or organization that has served as a leader in integrating valuable benchmarks upon the region, and has made a significant impact in the South County in the past year.



Outstanding Corporate Citizen –
