The South County Economic Development Council (SCEDC) is seeking members to participate in the development of a Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) for the southern and eastern portions of San Diego County. The CEDS is designed to bring together the public and private sectors in the creation of an economic road map to diversify and strengthen the regional economies. An approved CEDS is necessary to access some EDA funding.

The CEDS Committee is the entity responsible for developing, revising or replacing the CEDS and must represent the main economic interests of the region. The CEDS Committee must be comprised of a majority of private sectors representatives. In addition, the CEDS Committee should also include:

- Public Officials
- Community leaders
- Representatives of workforce boards,
- Representatives of institutions of higher education
- Minority and labor groups
- Private individuals
